Teacher Instruction:

The learners are given a copy of the unpunctuated text below.

Learners are to punctuate the text with capitals, full stops, speech marks, commas, question mark and macrons. Learners will need to know capitals, full stops, speech marks, commas, question mark and macrons to complete this activity. Write these on the board with the symbol beside it.

- Pānuitia ngā kōrero katoa i te tīmatanga.
- Pānuitia anō, me te āta whiriwhiri i ngā wāhi e mutu ai tētahi rerenga kōrero, e tīmata ai tētahi, e āhua hikina ai rānei te kōrero mō tētahi wā poto.
- Pānuitia anō, ka whakamātau i ngā wāhi kua tohua e koe kia mutu, ka hikina rānei te kōrero.
